



L2 - Single Race Leasing Agreement
Under the Rules of Racing

This form is intended for use by those wishing to lease a horse for the purposes of running in a single specified race. It covers all registrations required to facilitate such an arrangement, unless there is a percentage split of prize money between the lessee and lessor. This will be a short-term registration, effective only from the deadline for declarations until and including the day after the race, after which the registration will be cancelled and the ownership of the horse will revert to the lessor.

BRITISH HORSERACING AUTHORITY - REGISTRATION INFORMATION

When you apply for registration of the arrangement your name and address details will be added to the database at Wellingborough. It is important that these records are correct and that no duplication occurs.

For a horse to be eligible to race, its name must have been registered with Weatherbys. It is important that the name of the horse is correctly spelt and includes the country suffix if applicable. Since the pedigrees of all horses racing in this country must be registered at Weatherbys, this will again assist in identification.

We need to know the Colours in which you intend to race. If you choose to run the horse in Colours already registered in the name of another person, we will need an email from the person in whose name they are registered, authorising the transfer of the colours into your name. It should be noted that the previous registrant will not be able to use the Colours on the day of the leasing arrangement. The lessee may temporarily register Racing Colours provided that they are available under the current criteria. This registration will be cancelled after the race has taken place. Sponsorship

If you intend to take the opportunity to arrange sponsorship of your racing colours, a separate registration is required.

The lessee may take advantage of the sponsorship sites as set out in the Code of Conduct for Owners Sponsorship, provided that this does not conflict with the terms of any existing arrangement which the lessor may have registered. Such agreement only lasts for the period of the lease. Please contact Ownership Services at Weatherbys for specimen agreement forms.

The lessee should complete the agreement form as the owner. The minimum lease period set out in section 1.1 of the agreement will be waived in the case of Single Race Leasing Agreements.

Any prize money won in the specified race is to be distributed in the following proportions:

Note: If the lessor is to retain 100% of the prize money this agreement merely confirms the previous position and amounts to waiver by the lessee of any interest in the prize fund. Any additional payments such as appearance money/sponsored number cloths will be paid to the lessor, unless otherwise stated.

If the prize money is to be divided the parties are considered to be in a Partnership and one will be registered. Please refer to the Fee Code in the Rules of Racing for the appropriate fee.

Declaration (to be signed by both lessor and lessee)

We understand that this arrangement will be a short-term registration which will be cancelled after the race specified above, at which time the ownership of the horse will revert to the lessor. We have agreed that any prize money won should be allocated as specified. We agree that, should the horse be sold or claimed from the race in question, the proceeds of the sale will be paid direct to the lessor. We agree, upon registration of this arrangement, to be bound in all respects by the Rules of Racing from time to time.

Data protection – by completing this form you agree that any information you provide may be held by the British Horseracing Authority, or Weatherbys Limited, including in their computer records and, where applicable, also by Weatherbys Bank Limited for the purpose of client identity verification. You also agree that it may be properly disclosed to other agencies registered to receive such information in connection with the management, regulation and integrity of horseracing. In addition, you agree that details of horse ownerships (including partners in a Partnership, Syndicators in a Syndicate or club Managers in a Racing Club) may be released to third parties. Fees

The fees commensurate with this application are payable by, or on behalf of, the Lessee. It must be made clear in this application who is responsible for the fees relating to this registration, as the relevant charges will be added to their racing account to settle. While the final charge for this registration will be determined following the termination of the Lease in line with the Fee Code in the Rules of Racing, the total cost will likely be £450 (£600 in the case of early closing races).
